Crash Site Recognition Federal Express Flight 1478, July 26, 2002

This is another in the series of short articles that I'm presenting in which I'm showing pictures of crash sites. I intend the articles to clarify the difference between what is and what isn't a crash site. It's important for people to be able to recognize the difference. It seems to me that the difference ought to be obvious but, apparently, some people have difficulty with it. In the pictures, notice the amount and the visibility of the wreckage. Notice, in some of the pictures, the skid marks, gouge marks, or scorch marks on the ground. Learn to recognize what is, and what isn't, a crash site. ↴

The aircraft [N497FE] crashed at 5:43am local time while attempting to land at Tallahassee Regional Airport on a cargo flight from Memphis, TN. With the Tallahassee Airport control tower closed due to the early-morning hour, the flight

crew received clearance from Jacksonville Center for a visual approach to runway 9 at 5:36am. The first impact mark was on a tree, about 70 feet high and 3,100 feet from the end of the runway. The plane first hit the ground about 2,100 feet from the end of the runway, and the first piece of wreckage - a leading edge flap - was found approximately 200 feet from the initial tree-strike point. The aircraft's landing gear was down at the time of the accident. The 727 skidded to a stop about 1,000 feet from the end of the runway and caught fire; the flight crew escaped major injury. —from AirDisaster.Com

Predators

child A person between birth and puberty. —*The American Heritage Dictionary of the English Language*

A child is somebody who hasn't yet passed through puberty. After puberty, the person isn't a child any more. Thus, the status of being a child is inherent in the human species. It doesn't rely on legislation or opinion. There's an unambiguous distinction. It follows that a (for example) 15-year-old female isn't a child.

pedophilia Sexual attraction felt by an adult toward a child or children. —*The American Heritage Dictionary of the English Language*

Evangelists consider any inconvenient definition to be irrelevant. They pick and choose their definitions in such a way as to allow them the maximum possible ability to control other people, and to punish anybody who doesn't agree with them. To the evangelists, semantics isn't a study of meanings. It's a weapon. Twisting definitions to their will, they condemn as a pedophile any man who is sexually attracted to, or who has a sexual relationship with a (for example) 15-year-old female. Logically, however, such a man isn't a pedophile because, by definition, a 15-year-old female isn't a child.

Some people, mostly women I expect, will object that a 15-year-old female isn't sufficiently mature to "deal with" a sexual relationship. I've known women in their 40's who weren't sufficiently mature to deal with a sexual relationship. Maturity isn't promoted by ignorance and it doesn't happen by itself. It's achieved by experience. For most of the history of the human species, women have been mothers (not "moms", mothers) by the time that they were 15 years old. That pretty much supports the notion that such a female is, at least physically, an adult. When or whether she might ever

achieve maturity, other than physical maturity, is impossible to predict.

statutory rape Sexual relations with a person who has not reached the statutory age of consent.

At the behest of the evangelists, the distinction between an adult and an adolescent has become a legal fiction. 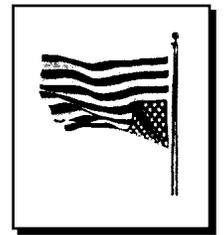
